
This photo shows how two banners look with highlights from up lights sitting on the lower awning. Keep in mind traffic patterns on Main Street when designating where the banners are to be mounted because the tree blocks a lot of visibility to the southern columns.


The awning lights are controllable LED's which can be set to almost any color.

In the picture below the mount hardware is a bit more clear to see. The process of hanging these banners takes two people about 30 minutes each. The removal time is 15 minutes for one person. This work must be performed by 800MAIN staff.







Grommet Details:

Hole ID: 0.375"

Material: Non-Rusting (typ. Brass)

Placement: 11 equal places along the vertical sides
